Call for Application

Japanese Society of Public Health Annual Meeting: International Participant Award, 2020

The 79th Annual Meeting of Japanese Society of Public Health (JSPH) will be held in Kyoto (Kyoto City, Kyoto Prefecture), October 20-22, 2020. Public health professionals, scholars, and students gather to share updated scientific evidence and practical experiences. JSPH invites public health professionals from all countries to attend the Annual Meeting. The meeting includes keynote presentations, oral presentations, poster presentations exhibits, and others.

Areas of research topics are: (1) epidemiology and health information, (2) health promotion, (3) noncommunicable disease and metabolic syndrome, (4) health behavior and health education, (5) parent-child health and school health, (6) quality of life and health promotion programs serving the elderly, (7) health and welfare services for the elderly, (8) social aspects of health in communities, (9) health and welfare for people with intractable diseases and disabilities, (10) psychiatric health and welfare, (11) oral health, (12) infectious diseases, (13) health-crisis management, (14) health system and policies, (15) capacity building of public health professionals, (16) public health centers, public health administration, community health, (17) public health nutrition, (18) health/exercise instruction, (19) food hygiene and pharmaceutical hygiene, (20) occupational health, (21) environmental health, (22) international health, and (23) health-and-care service research.

<u>International Participant Award (IPA) grants are available to</u> those who (1) will attend the meeting, (2) registered an abstract for oral/poster presentation in English, and (3) are from the following groups:

(category-a) non-Japanese students/young-professionals working/studying <u>outside</u> of Japan [hereinafter, **International**], or (category-b) international students (ryugaku-sei) working/studying <u>in</u> Japan [hereinafter, **Ryugaku-sei**].

Eligible applicants:

- 1. Registered for attendance to the 79th JSPH Annual Meeting (Kyoto City) on the conference website
- 2. Registered an abstract in English as its first author (oral or poster) on the conference website
- 3. As of May 31, 2020, be (a) non-Japanese students/young-professionals working/studying outside of Japan or (b) international students (ryugaku-sei) working/studying in Japan.
- 4. Paid fully for attendance to the 79th JSPH Annual Meeting (Kyoto City) (If a student applicant applies for a discount participation fee, and it is accepted, payment according to the discount amount is acceptable.)
- 5. Have never received a JSPH IPA grants before in the same category
- 6. Be younger than 45 years-old as of May 31, 2020
- 7. Be a member of JSPH [Those who apply for category-a can apply without payment of membership fee and annual meeting participation and presentation fee. Those who are awarded will be waived for those fees. Those who are not awarded should complete payment by specified date, for their presentation at the conference so that their names can be listed in the annual meeting program book]

Amount of IPA grant by categories:

(a) International: 120,000 Yen (which includes 8,000 for 1-year membership fee and 12,000 for annual meeting participation and presentation fee)

Maximum number of awardees, (a) and (b) in total: 10

(b) Ryugaku-sei: 30,000 Yen

- 3. Application form (Form A)

Evaluation/Selection: Selection Committee will review application documents and select candidates. Evaluation criteria are: (A) Importance as public health research; (B) Validity of application of methods and presentation of results; and (C) Potential significance for international exchange in public health research/practice. Results of selection will be informed to applicants in advance of the meeting.
